

CALLING ALL MYSTERY READERS!



I would like to invite any parents, older siblings, grandparents, relatives, or other special people to surprise your child by being a “Mystery Reader” this year in our classroom. Students will *LOVE* having their family, friends, and relatives visit our classroom to share in our learning by reading a favorite story aloud to our class. Mystery Readers will visit us on Fridays from 12:00 – 12:30 p.m. (You can stay and have lunch with the class from 12:30 -12:55 if you would like!) Mystery Readers are asked to bring a book to read or read a teacher-chosen book from our classroom library. You could read a whole picture book or a favorite part of a chapter book. You do not have to read for the entire 30 minutes, but you have 30 minutes if you need it. You will also be asked to send in clues about yourself during the week so the class can guess who might be coming to read (more details about that later!)

I have attached a list of dates that are available. Please check off at least two dates (if possible) that will work for you so that I can accommodate the most people. You can either email me your preferred dates or send your top three choices in a “top secret” envelope to school with your child. I will get back to you as soon as I can to confirm your official Mystery Reader date. I will also send you information about giving clues.

Remember, you are a **mystery** to the class, so try not to tell your child when you will be coming!
